SLOATSBURG MUNICIPAL POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS 2024

In order to provide for maximum safety and supervision, the following rules and regulations must be obeyed. Failure to do so will result in temporary or permanent dismissal from the pool. The Municipal Pool will open at 10 a.m., Monday through Sunday, with alternating closing times.

I. ADMISSION

- a) Admission to Pool is by Membership only. (Proof of residence required)
- b) In order to qualify for admission to the Sloatsburg Municipal Pool, you must either be a **FULL-TIME RESIDENT** of the Village or a guest of a member. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times.

II. FEES:

ADULT:16 years of age or olderCHILD:Under the age of 16

- a) <u>Family Membership</u> constitutes the **IMMEDIATE FAMILY**, example: Father, Mother, Son(s) and Daughter(s). For the purpose of this regulation, **FOSTER CHILDREN** living in the home of a Village Resident will be deemed to be members of the immediate family of that Village Resident. The Village reserves the right to require proof of fostering status. **The fee is \$400.00**.
- b) <u>Individual Membership</u> constitutes a single person, residing in the Village of Sloatsburg as a full-time resident. Fee is \$175.00.
 * Those who reside in a household, but are not a part of the immediate family, and are not full-time residents will be required to pay for an Individual Membership which is \$175.00.
- c) <u>Senior Citizens</u>, 65 years of age or older, Fee is **\$40.00**.
- d) <u>Daily Guest Fees</u>

*All guests must be accompanied by a member at all times

Weekdays, Monday thru Friday: \$10.00 per adult / \$5.00 per child Weekends, Saturday and Sunday: \$10.00 per adult / \$5.00 per child

f) All children under the **age of 12 must be accompanied by a person 16** years of age or over.

III. HEALTH REGULATIONS AND BATHING ATTIRE

- a) Pollution of swimming pools is prohibited. Urinating, expectorating, or blowing your nose in any swimming pool is prohibited.
- b) Communicable Disease. No person having skin lesions; sore or inflamed eyes, mouth, nose, or ear discharges; or who is known to be a carrier of the micro-organisms of any communicable disease, shall use any swimming pool or bathing beach. No regular diapers are allowed in pools. Swim diapers are required for any children who are not toilet trained.
- c) All persons shall wear appropriate bathing attire. Anyone wearing clothing that, in the judgment of the person in charge, is not considered appropriate, will not be permitted to swim.
- d) Spectators: Persons not dressed for bathing shall not be permitted to use walks immediately adjacent to the swimming pools.
- e) All persons are required to take a shower before entering the pool.

IV. CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR

The following shall be **PROHIBITED**:

- a) Running on the concrete pavement that surrounds the pool.
- b) Anyone caught throwing gravel or any other object in the pool or in any way doing harm to the shrubbery and to the trees will be expelled from the pool. The second offense will result in expulsion from the pool for one week.
- c) Hanging on or playing with the flotation markers.
- d) Climbing on or sitting on the lifeguard chairs.
- e) Vandalism will not be tolerated. Those persons apprehended shall be responsible for replacement and cost of damaged property. The acts of minors shall be the responsibility of parents. Automatic expulsion of those found violating the above will result in the loss of swimming privileges for the <u>entire season</u>.
- f) No toys or objects of play permitted in any pool at any time. No flotation devices are allowed. This will be strictly enforced.
- g) As per Section 35-13 of the Village Ordinance, no person shall use any vulgar, profane, obscene, threatening, abusive or insulting language.

V. <u>FOOD</u>

- a) Food, regardless of its nature, will not be permitted on the concrete pavement surrounding the pools.
- b) At no time will alcoholic beverages or glass containers of any sort be permitted in the pool area.

VI. <u>HOURS*</u>

*From June 22nd through August 2nd.

Commencing August 3, 2024, the pool will close at 7:30 each night.

- **b)** There will be no admittance to the pool or the pool area except during authorized hours. Violations will result in the loss of pool privileges for the entire season.
- c) RESIDENTS AND GUESTS are responsible for any injuries and all costs associated therewith.
